CANA 660. Specialty Anatomy. 2 hours.

An elective in Anatomy taken outside the University of Illinois College of Medicine with prior approval. Course Information: Field work required. Prerequisite(s): Completion of 3rd Year.

CANA 690. Away Rotation in Anatomy. 1-15 hours.

An elective in Anatomy taken outside the University of Illinois College of Medicine with prior approval. Course Information: May be repeated. Students may enroll in more than one section per term. Field work required. Prerequisite(s): Completion of 3rd Year.

CANA 694. Special Topics in Anatomy. 1-15 hours.

Special or new topics in Anatomy. Course Information: May be repeated. Students may enroll in more than one section per term. Field work required. Prerequisite(s): Completion of 3rd Year.

CANA 696. Individualized Elective in Anatomy. 1-15 hours.

Self-designed elective in Anatomy under the supervision of a faculty member or physician to fit students' interests or customized experiences with prior approval. Course Information: May be repeated. Students may enroll in more than one section per term. Field work required. Prerequisite(s): Completion of 3rd Year.

CANA 697. Research Elective in Anatomy. 1-15 hours.

Student-proposed research under a faculty member in Anatomy; available with prior approval. Course Information: May be repeated. Students may enroll in more than one section per term. Field work required. Prerequisite(s): Completion of 3rd Year.
