PCBP 660. Critical Thinking Using the Scientific Method. 4-8 hours.

Introduce the student to the critical thinking foundations of scientific research, including developing a research proposal, formulating testable hypotheses, collecting reliable and valid data, and preparing written reports. Course Information: Field work required. Prerequisite(s): Completion of 3rd Year.

PCBP 690. Away Rotation in Cancer Biology, & Pharmacology. 1-15 hours.

An elective in Cancer Biology and Pharmacology taken outside the University of Illinois College of Medicine with prior approval. Course Information: May be repeated. Students may enroll in more than one section per term. Field work required. Prerequisite(s): Completion of 3rd Year.

PCBP 694. Special Topics in Cancer Biology, & Pharmacology. 1-15 hours.

Special or new topics in Cancer Biology and Pharmacology. Course Information: May be repeated. Students may enroll in more than one section per term. Field work required. Prerequisite(s): Completion of 3rd Year.

PCBP 696. Individualized Elective in Cancer Biology, & Pharmacology. 1-15 hours.

Individualized elective in Cancer Biology and Pharmacology under the supervision of a faculty member or physician to fit students' interests or customized experiences with prior approval. Course Information: May be repeated. Students may enroll in more than one section per term. Field work required. Prerequisite(s): Completion of 2nd Year.

PCBP 697. Research Elective in Cancer Biology, & Pharmacology. 1-15 hours.

Student-proposed research under a faculty member in Cancer Biology and Pharmacology; available with prior approval. Course Information: May be repeated. Students may enroll in more than one section per term. Field work required. Prerequisite(s): Completion of 2nd Year.
