Courses

PDRM 602. Dermatology. 2 hours.

This dermatology elective is designed to provide a basic knowledge of the common skin lesions seen in practice. Students will learn how to perform a thorough skin examination, identify physical exam findings. Course Information: Field work required. Prerequisite(s): Completion of 3rd Year.

PDRM 690. Away Rotation in Dermatology. 1-15 hours.

An elective in Dermatology taken outside the University of Illinois College of Medicine with prior approval. Course Information: May be repeated. Students may enroll in more than one section per term. Field work required. Prerequisite(s): Completion of 3rd Year.

PDRM 694. Special Topics in Dermatology. 1-15 hours.

Special or new topics in Dermatology. Course Information: May be repeated. Students may enroll in more than one section per term. Field work required. Prerequisite(s): Completion of 3rd Year.

PDRM 696. Individualized Elective in Dermatology. 1-15 hours.

Individualized elective in Dermatology under the supervision of a faculty member or physician to fit students' interests or customized experiences with prior approval. Course Information: May be repeated. Students may enroll in more than one section per term. Field work required. Prerequisite(s): Completion of 2nd Year.

PDRM 697. Research Elective in Dermatology. 1-15 hours.

Student-proposed research under a faculty member in Dermatology; available with prior approval. Course Information: May be repeated. Students may enroll in more than one section per term. Field work required. Prerequisite(s): Completion of 2nd Year.
