Courses

CNEU 601. Advanced Neurology. 4 hours.

The objective of this program is to give the student advanced clinical experience in neurology beyond the required specialty rotation. Course Information: Field work required. Prerequisite(s): Completion of 3rd Year.

CNEU 690. Away Rotation in Neurology. 1-15 hours.

An elective in Neurology taken outside the University of Illinois College of Medicine with prior approval. Course Information: May be repeated. Students may enroll in more than one section per term. Field work required. Prerequisite(s): Completion of 3rd Year.

CNEU 694. Special Topics in Neurology. 1-15 hours.

Special or new topics in Neurology. Course Information: May be repeated. Students may enroll in more than one section per term. Field work required. Prerequisite(s): Completion of 3rd Year.

CNEU 696. Individualized Elective in Neurology. 1-15 hours.

Individualized elective in Neurology under the supervision of a faculty member or physician to fit students' interests or customized experiences with prior approval. Course Information: May be repeated. Students may enroll in more than one section per term. Field work required. Prerequisite(s): Completion of 3rd Year.

CNEU 697. Research Elective in Neurology. 1-15 hours.

Student-proposed research under a faculty member in Neurology; available with prior approval. Course Information: May be repeated. Students may enroll in more than one section per term. Field work required. Prerequisite(s): Completion of 2nd Year.
