

MD - Rehabilitation Medicine and Restorative Medical Science-Chicago (CRMR)

Courses

CRMR 601. Physical Medicine & Rehabilitation. 2-4 hours.

This elective will include working with faculty for a two week or four week interval focusing on outpatient Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation.

Course Information: Field work required. Prerequisite(s): Completion of 3rd Year.

CRMR 690. Away Rotation in Rehabilitation Medicine and Restorative Medical Science. 1-15 hours.

An elective in Rehabilitation Medicine and Restorative Medical Science taken outside the University of Illinois College of Medicine with prior approval. Course Information: May be repeated. Students may enroll in more than one section per term. Field work required. Prerequisite(s): Completion of 3rd Year.

CRMR 694. Special Topics in Rehabilitation Medicine and Restorative Medical Science. 1-15 hours.

Special or new topics in Rehabilitation Medicine and Restorative Medical Science. Course Information: May be repeated. Students may enroll in more than one section per term. Field work required. Prerequisite(s): Completion of 3rd Year.

CRMR 696. Individualized Elective in Rehabilitation Medicine and Restorative Medical Science. 1-15 hours.

Individualized elective in Rehabilitation Medicine and Restorative Medical Science under the supervision of a faculty member or physician to fit students' interests or customized experiences with prior approval. Course Information: May be repeated. Students may enroll in more than one section per term. Field work required. Prerequisite(s): Completion of 2nd Year.

CRMR 697. Research Elective in Rehabilitation Medicine and Restorative Medical Science. 1-15 hours.

Student-proposed research under a faculty member in Rehabilitation Medicine and Restorative Medical Science; available with prior approval. Course Information: May be repeated. Students may enroll in more than one section per term. Field work required. Prerequisite(s): Completion of 2nd Year.
