PNSG 607. Neurological Surgery. 2-4 hours.

The student will be directly involved with the initial evaluation and subsequent treatment of neurosurgical patients. Course Information: Field work required. Prerequisite(s): Completion of 3rd Year.

PNSG 690. Away Rotation in Neurosurgery. 1-15 hours.

An elective in Neurosurgery taken outside the University of Illinois College of Medicine with prior approval. Course Information: May be repeated. Students may enroll in more than one section per term. Field work required. Prerequisite(s): Completion of 3rd Year.

PNSG 694. Special Topics in Neurosurgery. 1-15 hours.

Special or new topics in Neurosurgery. Course Information: May be repeated. Students may enroll in more than one section per term. Field work required. Prerequisite(s): Completion of 3rd Year.

PNSG 696. Individualized Elective in Neurosurgery. 1-15 hours.

Individualized elective in Neurosurgery under the supervision of a faculty member or physician to fit students' interests or customized experiences with prior approval. Course Information: May be repeated. Students may enroll in more than one section per term. Field work required. Prerequisite(s): Completion of 2nd Year.

PNSG 697. Research Elective in Neurosurgery. 1-15 hours.

Student-proposed research under a faculty member in Neurosurgery; available with prior approval. Course Information: May be repeated. Students may enroll in more than one section per term. Field work required. Prerequisite(s): Completion of 2nd Year.
